

Instructions for Repainting

Bullet Camera





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Precautions

This document provides general instructions on repainting Hanwha Vision's Bullet Cameras. If you want to change their appearance, you should first understand the content of this document.



Please note that Hanwha Vision is not responsible for any problems caused by repainting.

Do not disassembly on your own without reading these instructions. If you do not follow these camera disassembly instructions, your camera could lose its waterproof capability.

Sections where you see any of the following symbols require special attention.



The risk is somewhat higher than usual.



Proper precautions for hazardous chemicals must be taken when working.



Important

If there is a 'Important' notation, apply additional caution when working.

Prepare the tools needed for your work, referring to the table and images below.



Names of Camera Parts


The names of each part of the camera are as shown below.

Disassembling the sun shield

- 1. Disassembling the sun shield
 - ✓ Turn the sun shield knob counterclockwise to remove the sun shield.

Repaint after removing only the sun shield while leaving the rest of them as they are. Do not disassembly the body. If you detach the body, your camera might lose its waterproof capability.

2. The brand logo will be covered when you paint.* Please note that separate logo stickers are not provided.

3. Before painting, peel off the serial number sticker from the body. After painting, the sticker should be attached to the body again.



If the sticker is damaged or lost, you might not be able to get any support from us. Therefore, make sure the sticker is not switched with another.

Masking

1. Make sure to mask the camera lens window. Any foreign substances on the window might affect the video quality.

2. Since there is an air circulation hole on the side of the gore valve, mask the whole gore valve and then begin painting. If the hole gets blocked, the internal moisture might critically affect the camera.

3. Mask the front interior of the sun shield and then begin painting.



That part is painted in black to prevent diffused reflection. If it is colored differently, the screen might suffer from diffused reflection.

How to paint



Paints most appropriate for the materials should be used for all painting applications. Paint can cause irritation to the skin or respiratory system because it contains harmful substances. It should never be swallowed.

Be careful not to let the paint touch your eyes or skin. Wear suitable protective clothing, gloves, and face shield.



For painting, you should choose a clean, well-ventilated place.

Painting

1. In the case of metal surfaces, paint with primer first for better paint adhesion.

If your new paint color is brighter that the current color, a white primer is recommended.

How to paint

2. Paint it once and wait until it is completely dried. Then, paint it once more (Two times recommended).

3. For the second painting, make the body stand straight up and paint it. Then, fold the body to paint any unpainted area.

How to paint

4. After finishing the painting, completely dry the surface for better paint adhesion.



That part is painted in black to prevent diffused reflection. If it is colored differently, the screen might suffer from diffused reflection.

5. When paint is completely dry, remove the masking tape.

Assembly

1. Attach the serial number sticker again.



If the sticker is not the original one that was attached at the time of the factory release, you might not be able to get any support from us. Make sure the sticker is not switched with another.

2. Reassemble the previously removed sun shield.
